

Materials Accepted for Curbside Recycling:

Plastic: All plastic bottles and jugs including:
Water, milk, soda, juice, liquid soap
Shampoo and detergent containers.
Rigid plastics, plastic utensils, CD's & DVD's

Paper: All Newspaper, magazines, junk mail
Envelopes, catalogs, bags, office paper
Phone books, cardboard packaging from
All food products, cardboard boxes and
pizza boxes.
Shredded paper must be bagged and
placed inside your recycle cart.

Glass: Any color glass food and beverage bottles
And jars, with or without labels

Cans and Metal: All aluminum, tin, steel and bi-metal
Food and beverage containers,
With or without labels, pots, pans, foil.

Styrofoam is acceptable and must be
bagged inside your Recycle Cart

Plastic bags are accepted but must be
bagged into one bag and placed in your
recycle cart.

Items Not Accepted for Curbside Recycling: (Please place in your trash cart)

Pens/Pencils

Plastic Straws
